DALLAS Trinity and Downtown The Connected City

2013, Dallas, USA
Chief Architect. The project proposes creating a balanced, mixed-density and mix-use city, that is essentially a "walk-city", with four new districts which are connected together and to nature. This connection with Nature distinguishes Dallas from the megacities of the world today. The plan integrates the toll-road and highways through a unified urbanism that links 4 new Riverfront Districts to the Dallas Downtown through a multifaceted mobility scheme which pulls citizens away from a singular mobility mode, adding car-sharing, Park & Ride, BRT (rapid bus 90%, rail 10%). The scheme promotes development around a series of inter-change hubs that seamlessly connect transport modes, and ensure one's home is walking distance from their job and daily activities. New Airport for the city of Qingdao, in the Chinese province of Shandong

2013, Qingdao, China
Chief Architect. The new airport located 40 km north of the city centre, on the west bank of Dagu river, will be part of the national transport infrastructure. The new terminal, to replace the existing one, will operate mainly domestic and cargo flights. The design should allow phased development within a 18.3 km² site, to process 38 million passengers/year in 2025 and 58 to 60 million passengers/year in 2045.

Chief Architect. Planning design, master planning, concept, schematic design and construction supervisor of housing neighborhood will include state of the art residential space with typologies that are both local and adapted to the special climate conditions of Chennai and humidity.
